This artwork is painted with encaustic. Encaustic is a mixture of beeswax and damar resin with pigment added. It's an ancient form of painting, and the colors of the encaustic paintings that have been discovered have endured throughout the ages.

In late winter my husband left for a month-long trip, and I stayed home painting and singing along to "Ain't No Mountain High Enough" and decided on that song title as my show title. I had no idea how prophetic that would be. My artwork took on new meaning as I listened to reports that Covid 19 was spreading around the world and creeping closer. Fortunately, my husband returned home before borders were closed.

Many of us have been pretty isolated, keeping ourselves from being infected, and staying away from friends and family to help protect them. Though we've been separated, we are can persevere, and can still love and care for those who we can't be with. I hope that these abstracted mountains can be a reminder that nothing can separate us from those we care about.
